April 27, 2007 FINDLAY, Ohio – The relocated Verizon Wireless Communications Store in Findlay, 224 East, is collecting no-longer-used wireless handsets and accessories through their HopeLine program for Open Arms Domestic Violence & Rape Crisis Services. The cell phone does not need to be a Verizon Wireless cell phone to help Open Arms. For every cell phone collected at the store from now until May 20, Verizon Wireless will contribute \$5 to Open Arms.

Open Arms accepts no-longer-used cell phones and accessories, of any brand, all year long. You can either drop off your no-longer-used cell phones at Open Arms' Outreach and Administration Office located at 401 West Sandusky Street, Findlay or have a collection box at your place of employment for cell phones.
